1. Approve October club meeting minutes (sent via email - available on website)

2. President's Report - Marten

- Tryout numbers – 116 players for 2010 and older, will attend open practice tryouts. Jon has been forwarding information to all teams. Please contact players and invite them to open practices. If you practices have ended, players can come back for practices in the spring. Reminder that if kids are coming from other clubs, they need approval from their DOC.
- Tryout numbers for 2011-2012 kids – 70 boys and about 35 girls signed up for tryouts. Tryouts will be rescheduled for the week after thanksgiving.
- Managers should be aware that kids may play AY and club at the same time, as well as other sports. We are in support of multi-sport athletes and the club will not mandate that kids must make a choice between the two.
- Thank you to Roberta for Amici's fundraiser, seemed to be good turnout, lots of take out, season end parties, etc. Hope to do one every couple of months.
- City Council meeting tonight at 7:00 to support lights at Stadium and Burton. Parks & Rec department is presenting their recommendation to city council, what they have learned from their study.

5. Fields - Jon

- Rescheduling: will have access to Heather and Burton in December. Air quality has impacted a number of games. Limited use of Highlands because it will transition over to baseball and softball. Make sure all game changes go through Jon. We need to make sure fields are lined, etc.

6. Referees

- Ref class scheduled and email sent out to people who indicated interest. We got about 40 names on the "interested" list, December 3rd is first class, December 10th and the field session on the 15th.
- Rich will send Lynn an email to forward to all families. Need to get more adults or high school kids involved. Will evaluate if there is a demand for the 2nd class, we will evaluate it.
- Thanks to everyone for participating in referee appreciation weekend. People brought cookies, money, etc. Refs really appreciated it.
- Requests from refs to reline highlands. Needs to be lined twice per season.

7. Manager - Christine Marcelli

- Reminder to managers to get intent to return and deposit. Best practice is to add an event to TeamSnap and ask people to mark availability for whether they are returning. Should do a

minimum of \$250 as a non-refundable deposit. This helps ensure people are committed to returning, and don't make a last minute decision to bail prior to the season starting.

8. Open agenda items and discussion

- Uniforms (Karen) – looking at options, will move by fall 2019, hope to get new 2011 teams into new uniforms. Will start up the uniform bank again to help out families during the transition.
