1. **Approve August club meeting minutes** (sent via email - available on website)

2. **President's Report - Marten**

- PCA – scheduled for 18th for coaches to try to get maximum attendance.
- PCA – had to bump session for parents because we have not been able to find space, 25th for parents at 7pm for parents in younger age groups, 18th for players' age 2005-2008. We will confirm and send out. Marten will send out an update.
- 2x2 meeting – 2 school districts, 2 city council members. TL Field space was discussed about building a sports complex, multi-use field space. City has money, school district has fields, trying to see how we can work this together.
- San Carlos Community Foundation – they got money from PG & E settlement, started a foundation, trying to bring in leaders of community groups to determine how to allocate the 2 million dollars (suggested to potentially reduce fees for kids participating in sports)

3. **Registrar Report – Josh**

- Player passes should all be set. Let registrars know if there is anyone that is missing. Sports Engine seems to be getting in the flow.
- GotSoccer, 32 of the 45 teams rosters are set so that primary players are assigned to the correct team.
- Registrars will be sending out note to managers about amount owed to club for fall dues and passes.
- Redwood league fee 25 teams have paid this so far. They will send reminders for people who need to pay. This is for scheduling referees for games. 04 and 05 still have teams in CCSL.
